Hands must be cleaned regularly (using soap and water if possible, otherwise using other approved hand sanitisers which are alcohol-based hand rubs) and especially after coughing, sneezing, using tissues or after any contact with respiratory secretions and contaminated objects. Disposable, single-use tissues must be used to cover the nose and mouth when sneezing, coughing or wiping and blowing the nose. Used tissues must be disposed of promptly in the nearest waste bin. Encourage everyone to keep hands away from the eyes, mouth and nose.

Any person that has a high temperature, persistent cough or any other symptoms of COVID-19 should not travel or turn up to site for work. They must follow the self-isolating guidance issued by govt. Anyone in contact with the individual confirmed with Covid 19 must self-isolate for 7 days or 14 days minimum or as government instructions.
